2021 Membership Rules & Regulations

Dual Course Membership

This annual membership program includes playing privileges at Farmstead Golf Links and Meadowlands Golf Club. Each member must abide by the rules and regulations listed below. Failure to abide by the rules, regulations and course policies of Farmstead Golf Links and Meadowlands Golf Club may result in suspension of playing privileges.

Starting Times

All members may utilize a seven (7) day advance booking period for the entire year of 2021.

When making a tee time, you are required to announce yourself as a member and whether you intend to play 9 or 18 holes.

You must notify the golf course pro shop no later than 48 hrs in advance for changes to groups larger than 12 players and 24 hrs for groups of 8 or fewer. For groups of these sizes at Farmstead, please email a list of player names in the form of a pairing sheet to the Farmstead pro shop at farmsteadgolfshop@gmail.com. For groups of these sizes at Meadowlands, please email a list of player names in the form of a pairing sheet to the Meadowlands pro shop at meadowlandsgolfshop@gmail.com. This information is valuable to assist with player check-in, golf bag loading, and starting procedures.

The men's and women's golf associations, including the Farmstead and Meadowlands Men's and Ladies' Leagues, have priority tee times Monday and Tuesday each week for the entire year. Management reserves the right to change the day of the week or tee times for any reason and will make every effort to notify the members of any changes.

Repeated no-shows, or showing late for tee times, will result in suspension or loss of playing privileges.

Member Discounts

Pro Shop – Members receive a discount of 20% off all regularly priced pro shop merchandise; discounts do not apply to equipment purchases (golf clubs and golf balls). You must present your membership card to qualify for discounts. Special orders require payment in full at the time the order is placed. We will not issue refunds or exchanges on used equipment.

Snack Bar – Members receive a discount of 20% off food and beverage purchases excluding alcohol and tobacco products. You must present your membership card to qualify for discounts. Discounts are available only at Farmstead and Meadowlands.

Only food and beverage purchased at the club is allowed on the property. No personal coolers allowed.

Members may arrange special outings through the food and beverage manager. The cost to the members will depend upon the menu. The food and beverage manager will provide all cost information.

The golf courses reserve the right to not apply membership discount to specialty items on a case by case basis.

Driving Range

Complimentary driving range use is available with your membership. Members are required to check in with the golf shops to receive range balls. Members are limited to two (2) complimentary units per day. Additional units may be purchased at the regular posted rate. Complimentary driving range use is for FMGA members only. Guests are required to pay posted rates for range balls.

Membership Tracking

All members must check in and present their membership card before each round of golf. For safety and tracking purposes, the golf course must have record of all golfers on the golf course.

Handicaps

All members receive a USGA handicap for the 2021 calendar year. The cost is included in your annual dues and includes monthly printouts of your handicap. The USGA handicap system is also used for handicap verification for tournaments, as necessary. Any scores entered incorrectly can be corrected only by the Meadowlands Pro Shop Managers. **Members joining after June 30th of the current year will be required to pay their prorated FMGA Membership dues and Handicap Service Fees.**

Tournament Entry Fees

Tournament entry fees are not included in membership dues.

Handicap Flags

Handicap flags are provided to persons that have a documented handicap. Carts that have a handicap flag are allowed to approach no closer than 15 yards to the front of the green at both Meadowlands & Farmstead. Carts are not allowed on the par 3 fairways, any tee box, or any green, which includes the sides and back areas of the green complexes. Course management reserves the right to restrict all golf cart traffic to the cart paths when weather or course conditions warrant. Please understand that golf cart traffic is likely to adversely affect turf and soil, as well as playability. We appreciate your cooperation in using care and exercising good judgment.

Walking While Cart Path Only

Members will be allowed to walk while playing the golf courses only while it is cart path only. No discount will be given.
